The Future of Our Schools: The New Law Made by Legislation



The meeting in the Federation council was recently held and the new law known as Novaya Shkola (New School) has just been created. The new law made by the directory of education has been created in the hopes of creating a better school curriculum through the reeducation of all students in the nation

It has been announced that all schools will be put on a new strict curriculum meant to educate and reform the next generation.
