Why Russia has Begun Construction on Gay Conversion Camps: A Glimpse Inside



Homosexuality has taken a toll in Russia.

Under Nikolai Putin, a series of camps designed to aim towards the LGBTQ community have environments on March 29, 2043.

Homosexuality has been controversial since its first introduction and Russia has now taken action to cure LGBTQ persons. Not only has this project been launched within Russian regions, but the idea has stretched far throughout Europe. Many countries have been influenced by Putin's idea and have taken consideration of what would be the internal views of these camps will be like as well as what

the goal of these camps are. Whether one is on board with this program or not, the gay conversion camps will be done by the year 2050.

Homophobia is precedent in society for all the right reasons; this sexual orientation does not exist and therefore it is up to the leaders to create a response on this fallacy. Homosexuality has been slowly corrupting young children, teaching them that same-sex relations are acceptable. Luckily, Nikolai Putin has shined light on this topic of importance that is now spreading from community to community. The way Putin hopes the camps will be perfectly designed, organized, and ran has been authenticated through papers and speeches.

Nikolai Putin plans to begin these conversion camps in a timely manner. It will take approximately 5-7 years to complete the construction of the desired camps, but Putin says “as long as gay people register into these camps when a few have been built, this project will succeed. It is all about time. In time, the queers will vanish.”

How these gay conversion camps would be filled is simple. Those who identify as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, or Queer will have to register their status at their local government offices. People who differ from heterosexuality will have to wear rainbow armbands labeled “LGBTQ.” Officials would then be able to single out LGBTQ persons in public environments.

In these camps, a set of bedrooms will be provided for the captive. The objective is to create a friendly environment for the LGBTQ community. However, if one does not follow directions or refuses to receive the conversion therapy that will be taken place inside of these camps, they will be terminated with extreme prejudice. Again, this will only be necessary for those who oppose the treatment. The main goal for these camps is to cure the minds of homosexuals psychologically and emotionally. This will be achieved through multiple therapeutic sessions, whether it be physical or mental. Putin has round up a number psychologists that are willing to serve as gay conversion therapists.

Conversion therapy is defined as the “psychological treatment or spiritual counseling designed to change a person's sexual orientation from homosexual or bisexual to heterosexual” (Wikipedia). Putin states that “Conversion therapy is the solution that will serve as a placebo to fix the minds of the confused [LGBTQ persons], it will bring the people together, and it will solve the misconception that strolls within society. Homosexuality does not exist and these camps will make sure the people are re-educated.” Other names people refer to Conversion Therapy are Reparative Therapy, and Sexual Orientation Change Efforts (SOCE).

Putin’s psychology staff has proposed a schedule a patient would have to undergo during their stay at these camps. First, the patient would be assigned a specific counselor for whichever category they align with. For example, if one identifies as transgender, a therapist that specifies with transgenderism would work with that patient. Each stage needed to move on to the next depends on the patient’s problem. Next, the patient would be filled with hope that they can seek help to cure their mental illness. They will be taught that they must be treated for their own good. The more

comfortable the incarcerated are, the smoother the treatment will move. Lastly, the patient would be rehabilitated and their stay at the conversion camps would be completed. Once the patient has completed the entire process, they no longer would have to wear the rainbow armband; however, they would still have surprise visits from government officials to keep in check.

In the first stage, the therapists will set a series of hypnosis sessions in which they will extinguish the same-sex attraction that they feel within. These sessions could last up to 8 hours a day, similarly to a school day. The longer it takes to complete these sessions, the more intense they will get. Once they pass the first stage, the patient would either enter the final stage, physical treatment, or electro-shock cleansing if they fail.

During physical treatment, the incarcerated would follow a course of tests and gimmicks. They would have to encounter other LGBTQ people inside these camps and testify their loyalty as a heterosexual. The psychologists have not produced an exact template on what the physical treatment would be like, but once more news is announced, the public will be ensured.

The most common way in which the subject would be disciplined is through electro-shock cleansing. This is a strategy of enhanced interrogation where the casualty is strapped to a metal casing and subjected to electric shocking. This treatment would only be necessary if the therapy sessions do not subject change of sexual orientation or gender identity. This method of teaching allows the patient to learn from right to wrong. By cleansing their brains with electricity, their thoughts and emotional feelings of homosexual relations would vanish. In some cases, this mechanism does not work. If the procedure fails to correct the incarnated, neutralization would be the only option. Not only is the intention of these camps to repair the living LGBTQ community, but to prevent others from obtaining influence.

“With these gay conversion camps, humanity will be restored. Children will be safe, re-educated, and loved. In time, the adults will too. It is up to us, your leaders, to start a movement to make our country great again. Other countries will soon realize that our actions are what’s right for the people,” Putin says.
